

Once again we bring to Bloomington one of the most diverse offerings of books for you to browse and purchase.

The collection includes popular fiction, unpopular fiction, books for highbrows, for lowbrows, and for those with no brows at all. Books for intellectuals and sensationalists. Books for those who read about cooks and for those who read about crooks.

About Hoosier Hills Food Bank

All proceeds from this event benefit HHFB. We collect and distribute over 5.7 million pounds of food annually. We rescue food that would otherwise be wasted from grocery stores, caterers, farms and wholesalers; operate government commodity programs; raise food through our garden program; conduct community food drives; and purchase food.

You might not know this, but we serve Brown, Lawrence, Orange, Owen, Martin and Monroe counties through a network of more than 80 partner agencies that include food pantries,

kitchens, shelters and other community based organizations. We also serve individuals directly through our mobile pantry and senior food box programs. Together, we feed over 51,000 people each month. We also assist those who are eligible in receiving SNAP benefits.

Over 39,000 people in HHFB's service area face food insecurity and the numbers are rising. The Book Fair is a major fundraising effort that helps us maintain our programs and meet our goals. Your book purchases help us in this effort.

About the Book Fair

The Community Book fair goes back 41 years and was saved 11 years ago when the HHFB stepped in to act as the host, with the support of a dedicated crew of long-time volunteers.

Book donations are accepted throughout the year (except in October). Donations include gently used books, puzzles, games and media (CDs, DVDs, LPs, and books on CD). Donors with a large number of books are requested to call in advance at 812-334-8374. Drop off your books at the Food Bank, 2333 W. Industrial Park Dr., Mon.-Thurs. 9:30-4:30, Fri. 9:30-12:30.
