

HHFB Partner Food Pantries

Our partner food pantries serve anyone needing free groceries. Some pantries may require you to meet income guidelines to receive some items, but they can provide other items regardless of your situation. Food pantries vary in size and selection.

HHFB Partner Community Kitchens

Our partner on-site feeding programs serve meals and snacks you can eat there or take home. Some also offer shelter. This brochure shows agencies open to the public. Our other on-site feeding partners include daycares, youth programs, and group homes.

Commodity Supplemental Food Program for Seniors

If you are over 60 years old and meet income guidelines, you may qualify to get a monthly box of food providing protein, calcium, iron, and vitamins. Contact Dave at HHFB at 812-334-8374 or foodprogram@hhfoodbank.org.

Federal SNAP Benefits

You and your family may be eligible to receive SNAP benefits (formerly known as food stamps). Only 60% of eligible people take advantage of this program. Even if you have a job, you may qualify.
